- 5. Assist in maintaining manufacturing equipment, including inspections to diagnose electrical/mechanical problems, replacement of parts, making necessary adjustments, and testing.
- 6. Assist in maintaining maintenance records and parts inventories.
- 7. Assist in maintaining building safety and security systems.
- 8. Assist in construction and renovations projects.
- 9. Property and grounds maintenance, including snow removal.
- 10. Attend training and perform other duties as needs develop.
